## Working plan for 2015

### Entrepreneurs.

We will develop the training of entrepreneurs. We will work with for example to get started training under the Focus Business School's concept. We will work to greater involvement in the churches and try to get Universities interested in entrepreneurship training.

### Businesses Program in high school

We continue to develop entrepreneurial education at secondary level, with the project name "Institute Mink Ondo", the Baobab church school. Teachers should be given more information, more education and are supported in their project to manufacture crayons.

### Eco-house and biogas project.

We design an eco-house with attached biogas and electricity from solar cells. Discussions are ongoing with the Congolese authorities for funding for a pilot project. Dialogue with the authorities will continue. The idea is that the house should be self-generating energy to modern equipment for a family house.

### Solar Lamps.

We continue to work with the imported lamps is sold. The business will hopefully be completed during the year.

### Agricultural Project, Nsanda Group.

We will follow the project. Some further investment is not up to date. Important now that loans are paid off. We will also work with other borrowers pay back borrowed capital.
